# **OUR JOBS ARE ABOUT SAVING LIVES AND EASING SUFFERING**

We are there when you are young, when you are sick, when you are in an accident, when you are old and when you are dying.

We have been there for you always, mostly recently during the first four years of COVID and we are now under serious pressure due to workforce issues.

We are the largest workforce in the public health system. We are the glue that holds the whole system together – covering all the allied health and health sciences, technical and administrative staff in our hospitals and health services.

We are your Pharmacists, Physiotherapists, Medical Imaging Technologists, Anaesthetic Technicians, Security Officers and Clerical staff – to name a few of our thousands of jobs. We work alongside our Nurse and Doctor colleagues.

The reality is that the public health workforce is in serious strife, struggling to retain and attract experienced professionals.

We want the best in public health care, but without better conditions and pay to make up for some of the huge losses to real wages experienced over recent years, public health will remain an uncompetitive and unattractive career option.

Important reforms and improvements to make the WA health system more sustainable are being met by the usual mantra: 'nice idea, but we just can't afford it.'

This tired narrative should be called out for what it is: the foundations of inefficient wage levels are contributing to a dysfunctional labour market marred by high turnover, chronic excess demand and qualified people choosing to not practice or work in public health.

This is the very narrative that got us into the current situation. Moving forward we must recognise we have alternatives. The choice lies in choosing to either fix deep problems in public health workforce pay and conditions or allow the problems to worsen.

An investment now will deliver dividends for WA health's future and sustainability.

An investment now provides the recognition and respect that the public health workforce deserves.

There will be some inconvenience and for this we are sorry. We take industrial action only as a last resort. Patient health, safety or welfare will not be at risk.

As a member of the WA community, please support us by calling on the Cook Government to urgently step in and act. If the State Government continues to sit on its hands, it is choosing for workforce issues to worsen.

We must have a State Government that chooses to fix the problems. We must ensure we can do our jobs well and safely.
