## DID YOU KNOW?

Ramsay Health Care, the private company that runs Joondalup Health Campus (public and private hospitals), has been cutting Allied Health Professional staff.

Allied Health Professionals are dedicated health workers, including Physiotherapists, Occupational Therapists, Social Workers, Clinical Psychologists, Speech Pathologists, Dietitians, and more, who are vital to patients managing medical conditions and recovering from surgery.

The staff cuts implemented by Ramsay Health Care means that:

- the remaining staff are stretched thin, under significant pressure and worried about patients;
- patients' treatments may be reduced or not offered;
- there may be longer hospital stays; and
- patients may be more likely to be re-admitted to hospital.

**At a time when the WA population and demand for health services are increasing, Ramsay Health Care must prioritise patient needs, not their corporate bottom line. Your healthcare matters and you deserve better!**
