Lodging Nominations

Nominations open on 16 June 2026 and must be received by the Returning Officer no later than 12 midday Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) on 30 June 2026.

Nominations cannot be withdrawn after 12 midday AEST on 30 June 2026.

Prospective candidates should verify their financial status and any other qualifications required by the Organisation's rules prior to lodging nominations.

Nominations must be lodged via the following method(s):

1. **By portal:** Visit the Australian Electoral Commission Portal at www.aec.gov.au/ieb. From this page, select “**Access the electoral event portal**,” then click “**Current industrial elections**.” Locate and select your election, then access the nomination documents.
2. **By post:** Sent to 10 Global Ave Essendon Fields, Melbourne, Victoria 3041
3. **By email:** A fully completed nomination form, including all necessary signatures, may be scanned and emailed to IEBnominations@aec.gov.au.

PLEASE NOTE:

- 3.1 When sending nominations via email, please use the subject line as:
“**ANDHB – E2026/34– Nomination [Name of Team and Electorate]**”

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON EMAILS:

- 3.2 Emails that appear to be spam may be blocked. It is the sender's responsibility to ensure their nomination email is delivered to the returning officer before the deadline.
- 3.3 Emails and attachments must not exceed 6 MB in total size.

Acknowledgment

You will be sent an acknowledgment of receipt of your nomination by email.

Team Nomination instructions

- Each candidate being nominated as a member of a team nomination must signify their acceptance of such nomination by signing this nomination form. *(Rule 23A(f)(A))*
- No member of a team nomination may nominate or be nominated as a member of another "team nomination" or as an individual candidate. *(Rule 23A(f)(B))*
- This Team Nomination form must include a nominee for **every position** for which nominations have been called. *(Rule 23A(f)(C))*
- A Team nomination must identify a Team Leader and their contact details. The Returning Officer will liaise with the Team Leader in all matters regarding the nominations contained within the Team. *(Rule 23A(f)(D))*
- Each team must identify a Team name which will be used on the ballot paper. Team leaders may chance the Team name up until the ballot draw. The team name shall not be offensive, defamatory or misleading. *(Rule 23A(f)(E))*
- Once a candidate has nominated for a team nomination the candidate cannot withdraw unless with the consent of all the members of that team. *(Rule 23A(f)(F))*
- Nominations for positions of Councillors of the NSW/ACT/QLD Branch (who have a separate team nomination form), the nomination must disclose the nominee's employer, location of employment, sub-branch (if any) and the local health district the nominee is employed in. *(Rule 23A(d)(iii))*

Team statements and photos

Team may submit a statement and photo to be included with the ballot material. Please email your statement and photo to IEBnominations@aec.gov.au following these guidelines:

- Submit your statement in Microsoft Word format.
- Keep your team statement to **300 words** or fewer. *(Rule 23A(g)(ii))*
- In addition, each team may also submit an individual statement of no more than **100 words** and a photo on behalf of one or more of the Team members. *(Rule 23A(g)(ii))*
- Include relevant information as per your organisation's rules. This may comprise your position, experience, suitability for office and the objectives and policies of the Team. *(Rule 23A(g)(ii))*
- Submitted photos must be less than 2 MB in size. Please note that all photos will be converted to greyscale in the final statement processed by the AEC.

Statements that comply with the organisation's rules and are received by the returning officer by 12 midday AEST on 30 June 2026 will be accepted.

Scrutineer Appointment

The appointment period for scrutineers opens on 16 June 2026 and closes at 12 midday (AEST) on 30/06/2026. A form is available from the returning officer for the purposes of appointing scrutineers.

PLEASE NOTE: It is your responsibility to ensure that your nomination is received by the Returning Officer **BEFORE** nominations close.
